

- 1. Cash incentive of Rs. 500 is provided to Dalit and minority communities to promote the use of ANC services, institutional delivery, post delivery service and immunization and growth monitoring.
- 2. NPR 500 provisioned as transportation incentives to all the institutional deliveries on top of NPR 500 provisioned from the central level.
- 3. Lab facility established in two HFs in FY 2017/18.
- 4. Sectoral meetings are conducted each month followed by a combined meeting to discuss progress, issues and challenges.
- 5. Population census was conducted in 2017/18 that will be developed into population profile.
- 6. Conducted Social Audit in all HFs and action plan is prepared for each facilities.
- 7. CCTV installed at municipal and health facility level.


